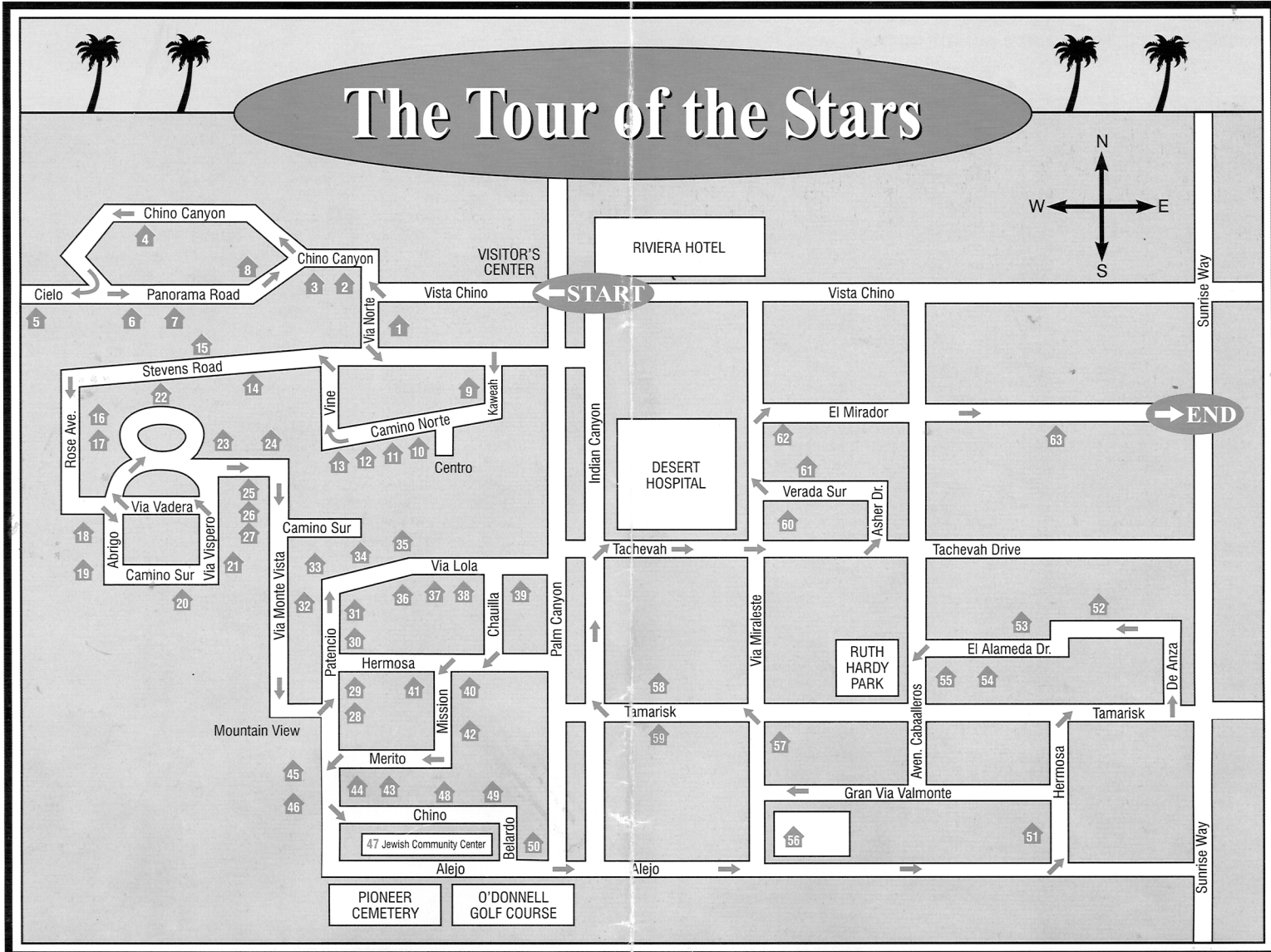


The Tour of the Stars



South East Corner

1. - (l) **375 Vista Chino - Milton Caniff.** Created cartoon strips such as Terry and the Pirates and Steve Canyon. He created a lot of his work here.
2. - (l) **424 Vista Chino - Jack Benny.** This home was built by May Company Heiress, Anita May in 1952. Jack Benny and wife Mary Livingston called it home between 1964 and 1970. Their radio show Coast to Coast on CBS was based in Palm Springs.

Turn Around and Left on Via Norte and Left on Chino Canyon Drive

3. - (l) **595 Chino Canyon - Zsa Zsa Gabor.** Former home of Zsa Zsa. Once married to Conrad Hilton. Miss Hungary of 1938 among other things: 7 husbands.
4. - (l) **845 Chino Canyon - Elvis Presley.** Built in 1946 by McDonalds Brothers. Sold to Elvis and Priscilla in 1970 for \$85,000, Elvis only owned two homes at the time of his death, this and Graceland.

Left on Panorama Drive. On top of hill by large rocks

5. - (r) **1090 Cielo - Magda Gabor.** Zsa Zsa's oldest sister, Magda, full-time resident, was married to one of Zsa Zsa's former husbands George Sanders for a short period.
6. - (r) **815 Panorama - Frederick Loewe.** Noted composer "Gigi," "Camelot," "My Fair Lady," "Paint Your Wagon" & more. Large portion of his estate was left to Desert Hospital which bears his name on one of the wings.
7. - (r) **701 Panorama - George and Rosalie Hearst.** Built in 1957. Oldest son of William Randolph Hearst and Uncle to Patty Hearst. Some of the statues came from the famed Hearst castle in San Simeon. Also, former owner, famed plastic surgeon, Dr. Reza Mazaheri. Betty Ford and other famous celebs were his patients.
8. - (l) **700 Panorama -** Built by owner's of the now defunct Sambo's Restaurants chain.

Right on Chino Canyon and then right on Via None to Stevens Road. This is the end of the "Little Tuscany Loop." Turn left on Stevens and turn right on Kaweah (also sometimes spelled Cahuilla)

9. - (r) **1441 Kaweah - Liberace's Guest House** where occasionally his brother George or his mother stayed. See mailbox.

Right on Camino Norte (the north road in Spanish)

10. - (l) **317 Camino Norte - Built by the Mirisch Brothers,** producers of more than 100 movies including: Hawaii, The Maze, In The Heat of the Night. Frequent guests included Alan and Sue Lad & Mary Martin, Dinah Shore and George Montgomery.
11. - (l) **323 Camino Norte - Former home of Alan & Sue Ladd.** They founded the Ladd Hardware Store in Palm Springs. Alan Ladd had to stand on a soap box to kiss his leading ladies.
12. - (l) **335 Camino Norte - Howard Hughes.** One of several homes in Palm Springs.
13. - (l) **365 Camino Norte - Mary Martin.** Best known for her role as "Peter Pan" and mother to TV's famous villain, J.R. of "Dallas."

Right on Vine and left on to Stevens Road

14. - (l) **591 Stevens Rd. Howard Hawks.** Directed and co-scripted "The Dawn Patrol" & "Land of the Pharaohs," Producer at RKO pictures. Made over 40 movies and closely connected with Howard Hughes whom he bought the house from.
15. - **670 Stevens Rd.** - Debbie Reynolds got her career started when she won "Miss Burbank." She was married to Harry Karl of Karl's Shoe stores.

Left on Rose Street

16. - (l) **1326 Rose Ave. - Marilyn Monroe.** Famous the world over.
17. - (l) **1258 Rose Street Nat "King" Cole,** then daughter Natalie lived there.

Left on Via Vadera and Right on Abrigo

18. - (r) **1139 Abrigo - Trini Lopez.** Full time resident of Palm Springs. Several gold records such as "Lemon Tree" and "If I Had A Hammer." Was discovered by Frank Sinatra.
19. - (r) **893 Abrigo - Horace Dodge.** President of Dodge Motors. Once owned by Mr. & Mrs. Friendly in 1979, owners of Tanforan Race Track.

Turn left on Camino Sur

20. - (r) 733 Camino Sur - Granddaughter of Helena Rubinstein once lived here. Left on to Vista Vispero

21. - (r) 1166 Vista Vispero - Col. Parker, Elvis' Manager and the man responsible for his career. Sold house and moved to Las Vegas. Passed away in 1997.

Left on Via Vadera and then right on Abrigo. House at end of Ladera Circle

22. - (l) 1350 Ladera Circle - Elvis and Priscilla Presley's honeymoon home. They lived here from May 1967 to 1968. Home has been restored to it's 60's splendor featuring memorabilia and 60's furnishings. This is where they fell in love with Palm Springs and consequently purchased their Little Tuscany home.

Abrigo turns into Las Palmas

23. - (r) 840 Las Palmas - Rona Barrett, Hollywood gossip.

24. - (r) 700 Las Palmas - Donald O'Connor. Song and dance man of the 40's & 50's.

Turn right on Monte Vista

25. - (r) 1295 Monte Vista - Peter Lawford who was named to Pat Kennedy and was a member of the rat pack. J.F. Kennedy was a frequent guest.

26. - (r) 1197 Monte Vista - Tony Martin and Cyd Charisse. Tony well known singer in movies and night clubs. Cyd danced with Fred Astaire and Gene Kelly.

27. - (r) 1123 Monte Vista - Dean Martin/Jeannie Martin. She got the house in the divorce and sold it.

Left on Mountain View and Left on Patencio

28. - (r) 816 Patencio - Marie Dressler, Canadian Actress of the 20's & 30's. Best known for her role in "Tug Boat Annie." Good friend of Greta Garbo.

29. - (r) 457 Hermosa (Corner of Hermosa) Large Estate behind walls. George Cameron, oil millionaire from Colorado, who had several wives and one was Anne Miller to which he was only married 1 day. Cameron received this house from a man named Duncan, of Yo Yo fame through default of a loan. 4 Acre Estate. Cary Grant was a frequent visitor.

30. - (r) 494 Hermosa - Lee Remick's brother. Famous Lipton commercial with Lauren Hutton was filmed here.

31. - (l) 975 Patencio - Mr./Mrs. Pollock - screen writers, now in their upper 80's -wrote all the scripts for "Dynasty" set in Denver. Also, used to write for Hallmark Hall of Fame and U.S. Steel Hour, plus numerous movies.

32. - (r) 990 Patencio - Former home of world famous author Harold Robbins

33. - (l) 999 Patencio - Jerome Robinson. Owner of a parking meter company, hired famous architect, A. Quincy Jones to design this home. This home was filmed during August 2001 for "Oceans 11" starring Brad Pitt, George Clooney and Julia Roberts.

Turn right on Via Lola

34. - (l) 550 Via Lola - Goldie Hawn/Kurt Russell, former vacation getaway home.

35. - (l) 520 Via Lola - "Miami Vice" designer home. Used extensively for photo shoots and filming because of it's unique modern design.

36. - (r) 515 Via Lola - Kirk Douglas. Used to spend weekends here with his wife - sold in 1999. Very philanthropic and involved with numerous charities in and around Palm Springs.

37. - (r) 467 Via Lola - Winthrop Rockefeller Estate. He was the Governor of Arkansas.

38. - (r) 425 Via Lola - Sidney Sheldon. Producer and author. He wrote and produced 'I Dream of Jeannie' and many national and international bestsellers.

Turn right on Chauilla

39. - (l) 1050 Chauilla - Former Warner Brothers Estate. Studio was launched in 1923. Jack Warner used to entertain here. Now the home of a well known screenwriter.

Turn right on to Hermosa

40. - (l) 369 Hermosa - Nancy & Ronald Reagan - owned while Governor of California. Then stayed at the Annenberg Sunnylands Estate in Rancho Mirage when they came to the desert.

Turn left on to Mission, on your right is:

41. - (r) 417 Hermosa - Estate was built by a Las Vegas business man in 1924. Features an all antique Italian tile Olympic size pool, 10,000 square feet of living space between main house and 2 guest houses. Also has air-conditioned dog house. Famous residents included Elizabeth Taylor and Ann Albright, model and covergirl. Southwest corner of Hermosa and Mission.

42. - (l) 776 Mission - Spencer Tracy and Kathryn Hepburn's desert hideaway.

Turn right on Merito Place

43. - (l) 465 Merito - Lena Horne/Lenny Hayden former home. She is a singer, and actress. He's an arranger and conductor.

44. - (l) 481 Merito - Built by Hoot Gibson. Famous cowboy actor. Later occupied by Mario Lanza the singer.

Turn left on to Patencio again

45. - (r) 701 Patencio - Mary Pickford/Buddy Rogers. Home has been extensively remodeled. Buddy was a full time resident of Palm Springs and socially active. Passed away in 1999.

46. - (l) 591 Patencio- Fibber Magee and Mollie. Radio show hosts, George Hamilton in late 70's. Note his signature in right side of driveway. Other residents included Burns and Allen, Walter Winchell, the Coca Cola Co.

Turn left on Chino Drive

47. - (r) Temple Isiah

48. - (l) 444 Chino Rd. - Sammy Davis, Jr., Singer, dancer, actor on stage and in movies

49. - (l) 222 Chino - Clark Gable and Carole Lombard. Gable also owned a home with wife Kay Spreckle (the sugar company) at Bermuda Dunes Country Club.

Turn right on to Belardo Road

50. - (l) 501 Belardo - Liberace. He arrived in 1952, same year as his television show made its debut. House includes the Safari Room, with imitation animal-skin wallpaper, Valentino Suite and Marie Antoinette Room, filled with French antiques. Current owner was a friend of Liberace

Turn left on to Alejo

On the right is O'Donnell Golf Course one of the very first courses, built by Tom O'Donnell in 1928 as his own private course. He and his invited guests played here until 1942 when it was sold to 25 members for a reported million each.

51. - 1148 Alejo - Frank Sinatra's first home built in 1947. Home is prime example of mid-century modern architecture.

Turn left on to Hermosa and then right on to Tamarisk and left on to DeAnza then proceed to El Alameda. Turn left on El Alameda (means "tree lined way")

52. - (r) 1232 El Alameda - Hedy Lamarr, labeled by the studios as the most beautiful woman of the 20th century. Star of Extasy, first nude movie made in 1933. House has been lovingly restored by current owner and reflects the 1930's Art Deco style which was popular during the period when Palm Springs was colonized by the studios.

53. - (r) 1188 El Alameda - Bob & Dolores Hope, the house was built in 1940. Hope also owns 30,000 square foot home on Southridge but stayed at this movie colony home when he was in town. Bob and Dolores were each honorary Mayor of Palm Springs at different times.

54. - (l) 1029 El Alameda - Dorothy Lamour. Glamour girl of the 40's. Dorothy and Bob Preston were two of the most popular Hollywood stars in the 1930's. They were often seen walking the gardens at the El Mirador Hotel in Palm Springs.

55. - (l) 1011 El Alameda - Bing Crosby with 1st wife Dixie-Lee Singer/Actor, winner of Academy Award for "Best Actor" in "Going My Way," 1944.

Turn left on Caballeros

Ruth Hardy Park

Ruth Hardy was the first woman to serve on the Palm Springs City Council during early 1940's. She also owned the Ingleside Inn for many years. Also was responsible for planting the palm trees along Palm Canyon.

Turn right on Gran Via Valmonte, pink walled corner estate

56. - Huntington Estate was built by the two daughters of Southern Pacific Railroad Magnet, Henry Huntington. The estate was the site of a wedding scene of the "Bold and the Beautiful" soap opera, and featured in P.S. I Luv U.

Turn Right onto Via Miraleste

57. - (l) 796 Via Mira/este- Woolworth heiress, Barbara Hutton estate. Once married to Cary Grant.

Turn Left on Tamarisk

58. - (l) 346 Tamarisk - Former estate of movie mogul, Darryl Zanuck, who produced such greats as "Patton," "Longest Day," "The Jazz Singer" in all, about 450 movies! This was THE party estate of Palm Springs. Frequent guests included Joseph Cotton, Douglas Fairbanks, Jr., David Niven, Marilyn Monroe, Rita Hayworth and many more. Son, Richard Zanuck followed in his father's footsteps and his production successes include "Jaws" and "The Sting."

59. - (r) 333 Tamarisk - Randolph Scott estate. Turn right on to Indian Canyon and right on to Tachevah Drive

60. - (r) 630 Tachevah - Charlie Farrell, known as Mr. Palm Springs, starred with Gail Storm in 1950's TV, "My Little Margie." He was also the co-founder of the famous Racquet Club in Palm Springs.

Turn left at Asher Drive and left at Verada Sur

61. - (l) 688 Verada Sur - Former home of Jim & Tammy Faye Bakker.

Turn right on Via Miraleste Drive

62. - (r) 1194 N. Via Miraleste - First home of Desi and Lucy Arnez. Southeast corner of Via Miraleste and El Mirador.

Turn right on El Mirador

63. - (r) 1055 El Mirador - Keely Smith. Famous Lounge singer, once married to Louis Prima.
